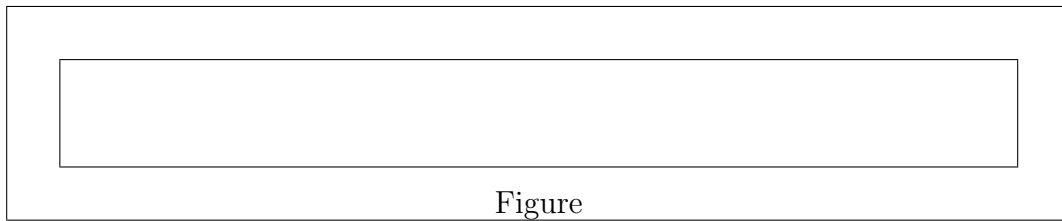


Fig.1 Example of figure
